### STAGE 5



CRITICALLY ILL WITH  
MULTI-ORGAN  
INVOLVEMENT

### STAGE 2A

- Sore throat or flu without fever or shortness of breath
- Cough without fever or shortness of breath
- Loss of sense of taste but still have appetite
- Loss of sense of smell
- Diarrhoea
- Nausea and vomiting
- Fatigue but can still do daily activities
- Muscle aches but can still do daily activities

### STAGE 2B

- Persistent fever for two days or more
- Breathing difficulty when doing activities
- Chest pain
- Loss of appetite
- Tiredness, especially after doing daily activities
- Require assistance when walking
- Experiencing worsening symptoms (cough, nausea, vomiting or diarrhoea)
- Low level of consciousness
- Less urination within 24 hours.
